## THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Gebie Services Pty Ltd ACN 124 127 153 be wound up in insolvency under the provisions of the *Corporations Act 2001*.
- 2. Andrew James Heard and Anthony John Arthur Phillips, official liquidators, be appointed joint and several liquidators of the company.
- 3. The plaintiff's costs be fixed at \$7,600.00 and reimbursed in accordance with subsection 466(2) of the *Corporations Act 2001*.

Subsection 35A (5) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (the *Act*) provides that a party to proceedings in which a Registrar has exercised any of the powers of the Court under subsection 35A (1) of the Act may, within the time prescribed by the Rules of Court, or within any further time allowed in accordance with the Rules of Court, apply to the Court to review that exercise of power.

Rule 3.11 provides that a party may apply to the Court under subsection 35A (5) of the Act for review of the exercise of a power of the Court by a Registrar and that any application must be made within 21 days after the



day on which the power was exercised. A party seeking a review can apply to the Court to dispense with any requirement of the Rules (Rule1.34).
